



The Michigan Science Center (MiSci) is a unique, fun and dynamic hands-on museum, offering programs that inspire curious minds of all ages to discover, explore and appreciate science, technology and math in a fun, dynamic learning environment. Through an interactive approach to science with engaging, hands-on exhibits, live shows, a 4D theater, a planetarium, lab experiences and more, MiSci strives to help launch the next generation of Michigan’s engineers, scientists and innovators, and significantly impact the cultural and economic renewal of Detroit and Michigan.

MiSci features four theaters, the Dassault Systèmes Planetarium; the Toyota Engineering 4D Theater; the DTE Energy Sparks Theater; the Chrysler Science Stage; a 9,800 square-foot Traveling Exhibits Hall; hands-on exhibit galleries focusing on space, life and physical science; Kids Town just for pint-size scientists; Spark!Lab from the Smithsonian and education and outreach programs. With more than two dozen ways to customize your MiSci experience, there’s more than you can see and do in one day!

ATTRACTIONS: The Michigan Science Center features many exciting attractions to inspire a curiosity and interest in science. The Science Center and all attractions are handicap accessible. Permanent attractions include:

- **Hands-on Exhibit Galleries** that address subjects such as motion, speed and direction, manufacturing, the inner workings of the human heart, the immense range of wave phenomena, the content and scale of the universe, and much more.
- **Chrysler Science Stage**, where science comes alive through interactive shows and demonstrations.
- **DTE Sparks Theater**, which explores the fundamental principles of electricity and magnetism, energy conversion, and the properties of matter.
- **Kids Town Gallery**, a place where pint-size scientists can become veterinarians, test the laws of physics in a field house, learn about mixtures and solutions in the kitchen of their very own diner, or just splash, crawl and play.
- **Dassault Systèmes Planetarium**, featuring exciting, live tours of our Universe
- **Toyota Engineering 4D Theater**, a unique, 4D multi-media experience.
- **Smithsonian Spark!Lab**, provides visitors with the opportunity to become inventors as they explore and engage with hands-on activities, interact with facilitators, and learn from local innovators.
- **Traveling Exhibits Hall and Small Exhibits Gallery**, a temporary home for special exhibits.
